

2-Handle Bag for School Kit

(Church World Service & U.M.C.O.R.)

Also for the Midwest Mission Distribution Center

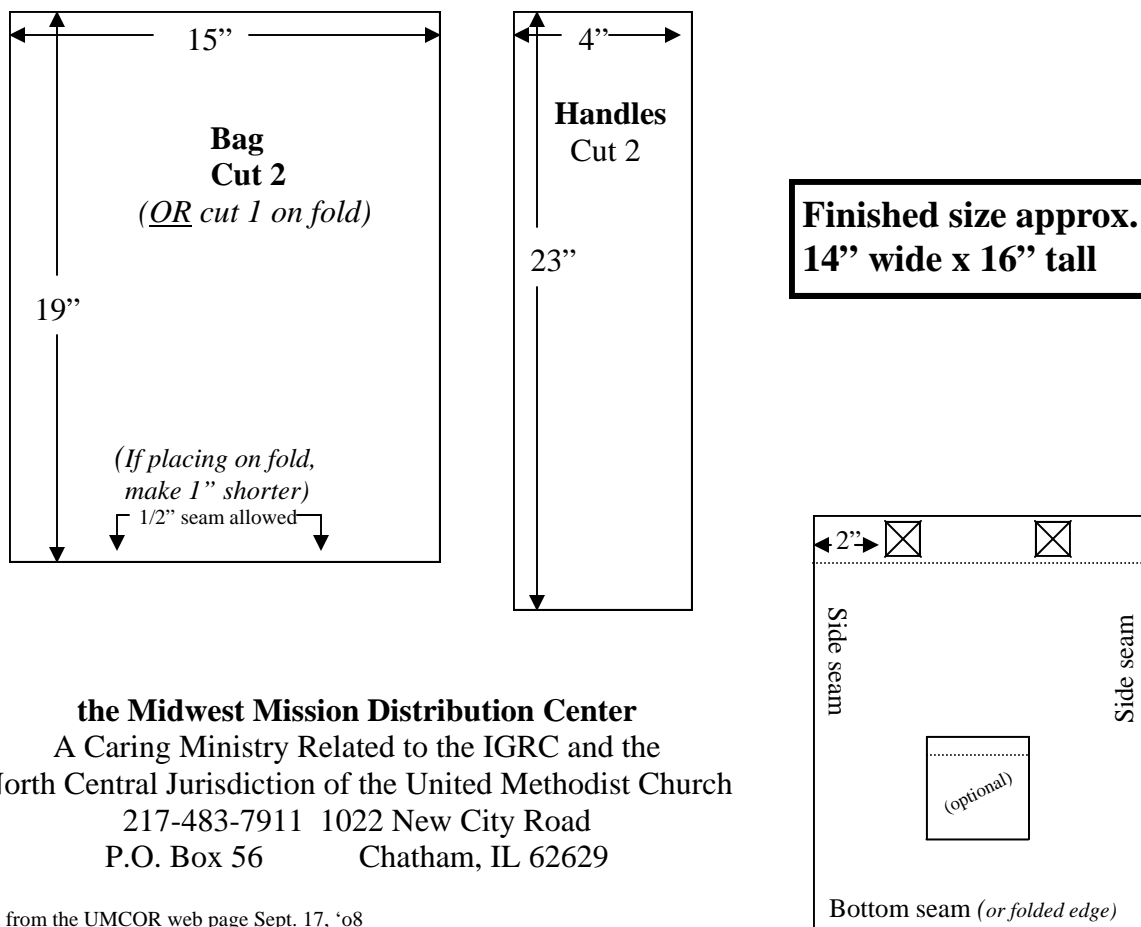
Cut pieces as shown, from **sturdy fabric** such as denim, corduroy, twill, drapery fabric, etc.

Place two large pieces with right sides together (*or fold the long bag piece in half*). Sew side & bottom seams using $\frac{1}{2}$ inch seams, and zig-zag or serge edges of seams. On top edge, turn down $\frac{1}{2}$ inch, then 2 inches. Sew this down. Turn bag right side out and press.

Press under $\frac{1}{2}$ inch on long sides of both handles. Fold handle pieces in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together. Straight stitch close to the open edge of both handles. Sew both ends of one handle to the front side of the bag and both ends of the other handle to the back side of the bag, turning under $\frac{1}{2}$ inch of the raw edge, with an "X" for reinforcement (as shown).

An optional closure (Velcro, snap, button, etc.) may be added near the top center of the bag.

Finished size should be approximately 14 inches wide by 16 inches tall.
